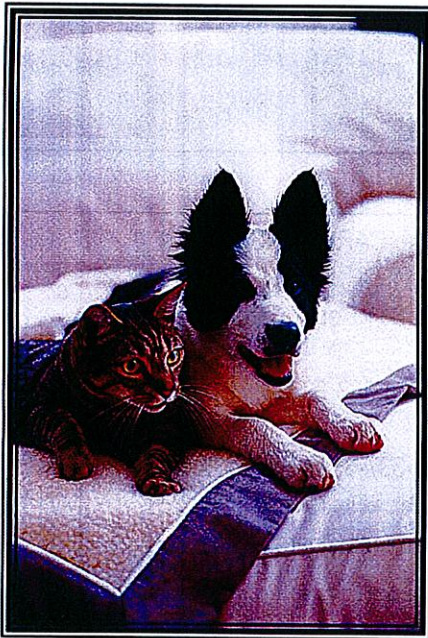




## Responsible Pet Owner's Guide



### If Your Pet Has Gone Missing.....

1. If you have a tag , your dog can be returned much quicker.
2. If there is a rabies tag, contact the vet clinic on the tag to inform them that you are missing you pet.
3. Print handouts and circulate them in the area
4. Send us a picture and we can put it on our website.

### SUMMARY

- Your dog needs to be on a leash when out for a walk, or you may be fined.
- If your dog barks excessively, you may be fined.
- If your dog poop is not scooped , you maybe fined.
- If your dog is unlicensed you may be fine.
- Ensure your cat does not travel where it is not welcome.

## *The Following Guidelines will assist you in our Authentic Small Town Living...*

Living in a community setting requires cooperation on the part of all individuals, especially those with pets.

Our pets provide companionship for many and are as much a part of the family as a human member is.

The Town of Carstairs requires you dog to be Licensed annually. You may register you dog or cat at the Town Office, located at 844 Centre Street, between the hours of 8:30 am to 4:00 pm, Monday– Thursday and 8:30am– 12:00pm —1:00pm – 4:00 pm Fridays. The fees for licensing are:

\$10.00 per year if spade/ neutered

\$20.00 per year if NOT spade/neutered

A dog tag is your permit to have a dog within the Town limits. Every dog must have a tag . Always keep the tag on the collar for quick identification .

All dogs must be confined to you property either by a fence , dog run or chain as dogs can chew threw rope.

### Respect your neighbors....

Do not let your dog's wander off leash and do not leave them to bark excessively during the day or night.

### Respect Common Areas.....

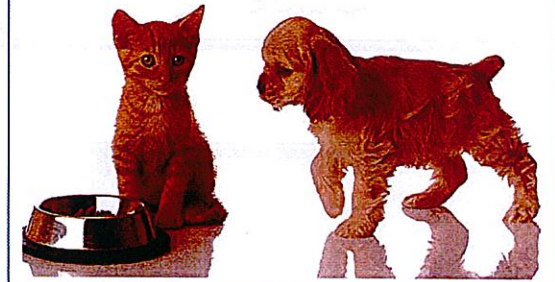
When out walking your dog , carry a bag and use the bags provided in the park if available to pick up after you dog. Failure to do so may result in fines being issued. Do not allow your dog to walk on other home owners front lawns and/or use them as a bathroom area.

Maintain your dog-runs/yards regularly to maintain health standards and control odors.

Have your pets vaccinated

Dogs and Cats both need to be vaccinated against parvo and distemper, to name a few of the viral disease
